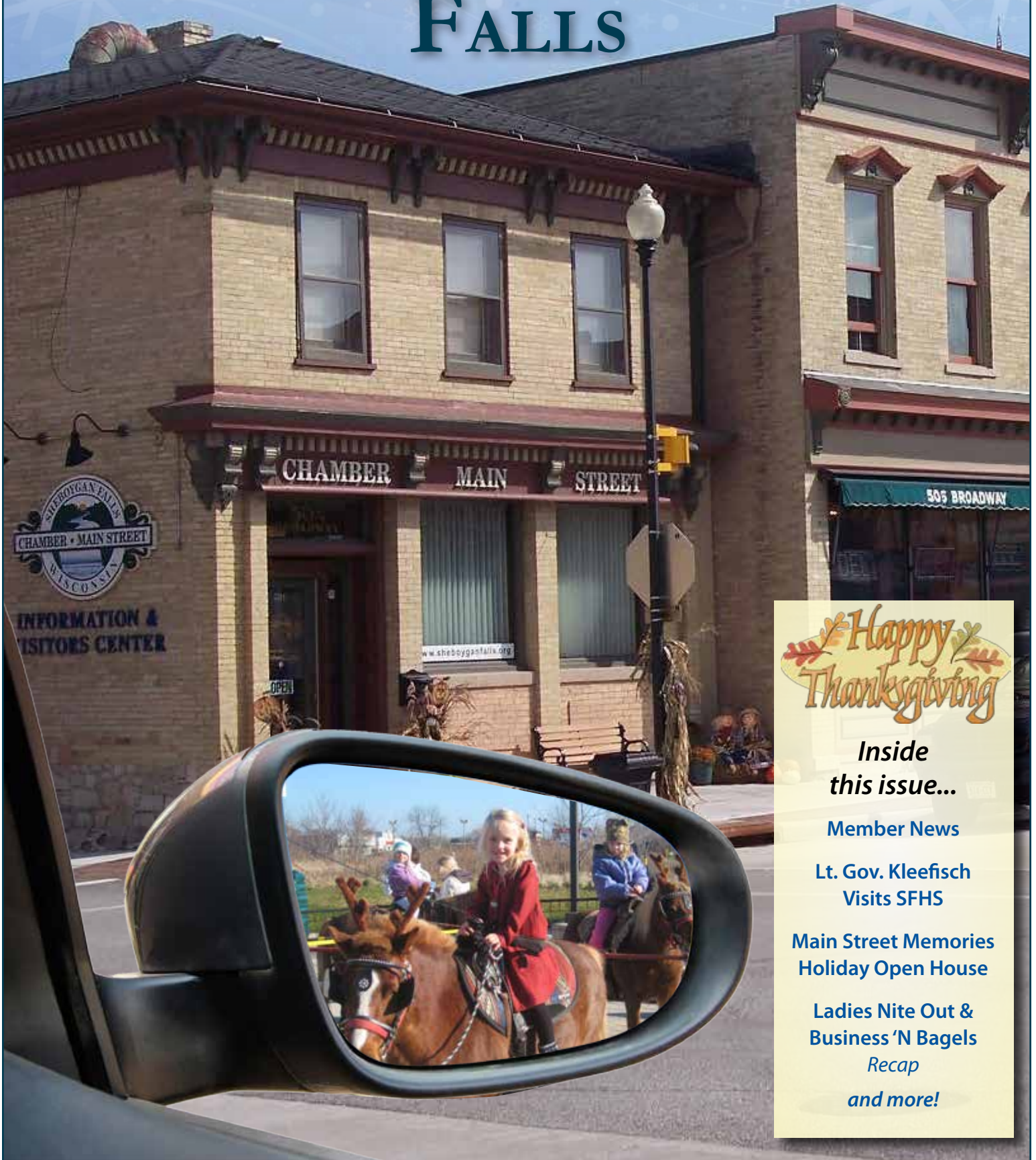

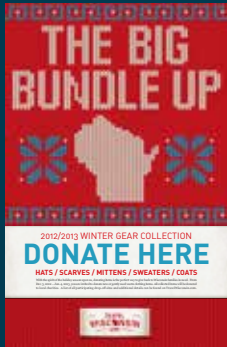
POST OPEN POSITIONS ON CMS WEBSITE JOBS LISTING
